TRAVEL ALERT!

The Selah Community Days Parade is being held Saturday morning. If you plan to arrive on the show grounds after 9 am, your alternate route is:

From Ellensburg

Take exit 26 (Training Center, Canyon Rd) from I 82 per usual. R onto Canyon Rd, Hwy 821. Take 1st L onto Harrison Rd, Hwy 823 until it T's at N Wenas. L onto N Wenas to light @ Goodlander. L onto Goodlander. Take 1st R onto N Railroad. Remain on Railroad thru traffic circle & thru the warehouses. Despite appearances, it is a public road but watch for forklifts.

L onto E Naches. Cross RR tracks & enter Monson Fruit Campus. Directions thru the campus to arena are on Show Details page.

From Hwy 12

Take Selah Exit from I 82 straight into town on N 1st St. Remain on N 1st passing 2 schools to light at Goodlander. R onto Goodlander. Remain on Goodlander to light at N Wenas. Go straight crossing N Wenas remaining on Goodlander. Take 1st R onto N Railroad. Remain on Railroad thru traffic circle &

thru the warehouses. Despite appearances, it is a public road but watch for forklifts. L onto E Naches. Cross RR tracks & enter Monson Fruit Campus. Directions thru the campus to arena are on Show Details page.

Thank you to most everyone for securing their dogs at their rigs, keeping the chaos in check near or at the show office and parking in the general member parking area. Parking right at the arena is reserved for show management only. If that's NOT you, please park in the general member lot. Show Management does not enjoy being the dog police, the parking police nor the kiddos police so please do your part.

For the May 18th show, remember that entries close Wednesday, May 15 at 9 pm. Late entries will go to bottom of the draw. Show starts at 9 am in the class order on the website Home Page. If you have not yet joined BMC, please print the Membership Form found on a link of the left side of the Home Page and give to Heidi along with dues upon arrival.
