Those riding for the buckle will have to qualify for the \$550 NNP meaning that they must be a non-pro and their horse can't have won more than \$550. Non-pro's riding for the buckle can't have won more than \$2,000 thus the class within a class. Watching the riders ride for the buckle is a favorite of all members and the awarding of the buckle is an emotional moment. We are so grateful to Gail Cox for sponsoring this buckle to preserve Jim's legacy.
